

Details for e-Poster submission for ISRTPCON 2023

- **REGISTRATION FOR THE COFERENCE IS MANDATORY** to present the poster in the conference. No poster will be accepted without conference registration.
- All original studies as well as case reports are to be submitted and presented in the form of e-poster. **NO HARD COPY WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- First author of the poster should be available for presentation of the poster as well answering any questions by assessors.

- All e-posters are to be submitted to isrtpcon2023@gmail.com on or before 10th Feb 2023.
- Poster evaluation will be done on 17th Feb post lunch.
- All participants will be given certificates for e-poster presentations.

- All e-posters should be in .pdf, .jpg or .jpeg format only. No other format will be accepted.
- Size of the file should not exceed 5 MB
- E-Posters to be made in Landscape orientation only with an aspect ratio of 16:9.
- The id number for the poster provided with the abstract acceptance should be mentioned on the upper left corner of the e-poster.

- Content of the poster should be clear, concise, written under proper headings and visible from a distance of at least 1.5m. Use bullet points as much as possible, avoid writing paragraphs. Use simple fonts properly contrasting the background colour.
- Relevant tables and pictures should be included in the poster. Pictures should be of good quality and clearly visible.

Posters should be made in the following format-

Original studies-

Title of the study- As mentioned in abstract.

Introduction, Aim, Methods and material, Results, Discussion, Conclusion and References

Case report-

Title- As mentioned in abstract

Introduction, Case work-up details, Discussion, Conclusion and References.

Best posters will be selected for presentation as Oral Papers will be announced after initial assessment at the conference venue.

Oral paper presentation will be on 19th Feb, Sunday after 11:00 am.

Duration for presentation will be 5+2 mins, 5 mins for presentation and 2 mins for questions.

Presentations for the oral papers will have to be submitted in .pptx format on 19th Feb, before 9am to the AV team at the conference venue.

Prize winners for Best Original studies and Case reports will be announced after the presentations.

Winners will be awarded Gift and certificates.
